



Return of Results

WHEN RETURNING RESULTS:

- Explain recency result does not change healthcare management
- Emphasize referrals and linkage to HTS services
- Report any adverse events, such as IPV, per routine procedures
- Encourage partner testing irrespective of recency status

PARTNER NOTIFICATION

- Describe options for notifying partner: **client referral, provider referral, contact referral**
- Discuss how the client can tell the partner to get tested.

Community-level result returned

WHY NOT

- Results cannot be meaningfully interpreted at the client level.
- BUT useful at community level: Gives us a better understanding of where and among whom new infections are occurring.

HOW TO RETURN

- Early implementation (first 3 months) - community-level data may not be available. Tell client to return in 1-2 months.
- Later implementation - Describe proportion in facility or catchment area who are recently infected. Use HIV recent infection surveillance report.
